Quay Queen

Quay King

Waterfront Weddings

Vancouver’s Bridal Row

New Westminster has become affectionately known as Vancouver’s Bridal Row, with a number of wedding and bridal shops along Columbia Street, just minutes away from Inn at the Quay.

LOCATION

New Westminster

Only 30 minutes from downtown Vancouver by SkyTrain, New Westminster is the oldest city in Western Canada and was once the capital of British Columbia. Today, New Westminster is a fabulous mix of old and new, with picturesque waterfront walkways and beautiful Victorian architecture.

Vancouver

A three-hour drive north of Seattle, the cosmopolitan city of Vancouver, British Columbia is set among glittering ocean waters and forested mountains. Vancouver was voted the "Best City in the Americas" in 2004, 2005 and 2006 by *Condé Nast Traveler* magazine for its ambience, friendliness, culture and sites, restaurants, lodging, and shopping. It is also the host of the 2010 Olympic & Paralympic Winter Games.

TOP 10 THINGS TO DO

1. *Feed the belugas at Vancouver Aquarium*
Get up close and personal with incredible wildlife at the Vancouver Aquarium. Hang out with and feed the belugas, learn what it takes to become a trainer, help feed the playful sea otters, or have a sleepover among the fish tanks.
2. *Shop Columbia Street's boutiques and antiques*
One stretch of this street, known as **Vancouver's Bridal Row**, is dedicated to all things matrimonial and is also adored for its attractive heritage buildings, galleries, boutiques and antiques shops.
3. *Paddlewheeler Riverboat Cruise*
Paddlewheeler cruises leave right from the hotel dock. Historic tours run to Fort Langley, and sightseeing cruises head to Pitt Lake. Other themes to check out: dinner/dancing, murder/mystery and wedding functions.
4. *Starlight and Riverboat Casinos*
Two 24-hour casinos are within a 15-minute drive of Inn at the Quay: Starlight Casino, Boulevard Casino. A free casino shuttle runs from the Inn to both casinos throughout all hours of the day.
5. *Ride the SkyTrain*
The SkyTrain provides a hassle-free trip to Vancouver. With a SkyTrain station right across the street from the Inn, guests can be downtown within just 30 stress-free minutes.
6. *Shopping on Robson Street*
Centered on Robson Street, Vancouver's downtown core teems with shoppers intending to scoop up the latest designer fashions. The street is also a de facto promenade, full of strolling visitors, outdoor cafes and authentic ethnic restaurants.
7. *Walk the Capilano Suspension Bridge*
Sway across the river at Capilano Suspension Bridge and Park, complete with a towering rope bridge, rainforest nature trails, a mini-forest of totem poles and the Treetops Adventure - a network of smaller bridges strung between the trees.
8. *Stroll the New Westminster Quay boardwalk*

Along this two-mile stretch, visitors can get ice cream and watch freighters and tugs ply the busy waters of the Fraser River. Visitors can make stops at the Public Market and Fraser River Discovery Centre before savouring the seafood at The Boathouse Restaurant.

9. *Watch the sunset at Stanley Park's Third Beach*

Walk the seawall pathway (10.5 km/6.5 mi), check out the totem poles and rose garden, and then have a late afternoon tea at The Fish House in Vancouver's dense West Coast forest park.

10. *Meet local artists at Granville Island*

Stop in at a local artisan's workshop or check out the boutique stores, theatres and restaurants, and famed Public Market at this 15-hectare (37-acre) mini-district.

SKYTRAIN

With a SkyTrain station across the street, Inn at the Quay provides guests with a stress-free way to visit Vancouver and all of its great attractions.

SkyTrain is the world's longest automated light rapid transit system. It moves riders quickly, efficiently and reliably across the region through 33 stations along the 49.5 kilometres of the Expo and Millennium lines in metro Vancouver.

- Running on electricity, SkyTrain is emission-free and energy efficient.
- Travelling high above traffic on elevated guideways means that you fly past traffic, on trains running every 2 to 8 minutes.
- SkyTrain is accessible.
- SkyTrain is bike friendly except at certain peak times.

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
